3. Answers to the following **essay questions** in a format that can be copied and pasted into your application. Word works well.
  - List your campus and/or community service for the past five years, including organization/club name, years of involvement, and positions held—may include volunteering at schools; Churches or community groups; giving blood; or other non-paid service.
  - List any honors or awards you have received in the past five years, including the name of award, year received, and awarding organization—may include academic awards, employee recognition, or civic awards
  - In a 2–4 paragraph essay, define your educational goals and plans.
  - In a 2–4 paragraph essay, define your career goals and plans.
  - In a 2–4 paragraph essay, describe your current situation, any challenges you have had in reaching your goals, and what you have done to overcome these challenges.
