		 I understand that I am responsible for the following expenses: All non-tuition costs, such as books, technology, registration, lab, and bus fees, on campus parking pass. Tuition in excess of allowable credits based on the number of courses enrolled at high school. Full tuition for any course below 100 level or courses offered during the summer. If you are a student who is eligible for free/reduced lunch at the high school, you can provide documentation to our Running Start Office to receive fee and book benefits. There are other ways to qualify, contact the Running Start office for details. 				
		The student is responsible for understanding when his or her choice of schedule will result in tuition charges. If the student enrolls for a combination of more high school and college credits than they are eligible for (as identified by the Verification of Funding Eligibility from the high school), the student is responsible for:				
		 Paying all college tuition and fees associated with exceeding the college credits identified by the Verification of Funding Eligibility; or
