Why are we asking for your help?

- ♦ The majority of students at CPTC have significant financial challenges. Most are firstgeneration college attendees and come from the lower end of the socioeconomic ladder. More than one in three of our students lives at or below the federally established levels for poverty. They have many challenges to face as they strive to learn the skills they need to be successful in their chosen industry.
- Challenges may include utility bill payment to keep the lights on to study, emergency food supplies, emergency rent payment, or medical bills. Emergency funding covers \$250 per quarter with a maximum of \$500 per calendar year.
- This support often makes the difference between staying in college or dropping out.
- CPTC students are here to make a difference in their lives, and in turn they will make a difference in our community.
