## **POLICY**

Clover Park Technical College seeks to provide access, as prescribed by law, to staff and students who need the assistance of service animals. In accordance with American with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Washington State Laws, service animals are permitted in and on college facilities/grounds. "Service animal" means any dog or miniature horse that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability. The work or tasks performed by the service animal must be directly related to the individual's disability.

Other animals/pets are not permitted inside college owned or operated buildings, except those performing a support function of law enforcement or specifically approved by the president or his/her designee. Dogs and other small animals are allowed on college grounds provided:

- a. they are under the immediate physical control of the owner/handler at all times (leashed or carried),
- b. are not tied to buildings or fixtures or left unattended, even in vehicles,
- c. the owner/handler cleans up after them, and
- d. the owner/handler assumes any loss or damage caused by them.
