- * Photo ID (Driver's License, State ID Card, Passport, School ID, etc.)
- * CPTC Student ID number
- * NLN Account username and password
- * \$10.00 for the additional testing site fee to cashing (building 17 | Room 107)

Testing Center Guidelines

- Please do not bring children with you during testing. Children cannot be left unattended on the college campus.
- When you check in at the testing center, the testing staff will ask you to store any personal belongings (wallet, keys, phone, food, drinks, jackets, hats, etc.) in a locker prior to entering the testing area.

NLN PAX Exam

- 3 Sections: Verbal, Mathematics, Science
- Time Length: Maximum 2 hrs 15 min
- Total Cost: \$50 (\$40 to NLN, \$10 to CPTC)
- Program Requirement: Score of 102 or higher

- **Check in at the Testing Center (Building 17 Room 250) with your photo ID and receipt.**
The testing proctor will help check in your belongings, and then guide you into the testing area. You will be provided with scratch paper and a calculator. You will need to log into the NLN website with the username and password you created to originally schedule your exam.
- **Please note:** You should already have your receipt and login information when you check in at the testing center. The proctor cannot allow you to test if you do not have your check-in materials.
