- Photo ID (Driver's License, State ID Card, Passport, School ID, etc.)

- * NLN Account username and password
- * \$10.00 for the additional testing site fee to cashering (building 17 | Room 107)

Testing Center Guidelines

- Please do not bring children with you during testing. Children cannot be left unattended on the college campus.
- When you check in at the testing center, the testing staff will ask you to store any personal belongings (wallet, keys, phone, food, drinks, jackets, hats, etc.) in a locker prior to entering the testing area.

NLN PAX Exam

- 3 Sections: Verbal, Mathematics, Science
- Time Length: Maximum 2 hrs 15 min
- Total Cost: \$50 (\$40 to NLN, \$10 to CPTC)
- Program Requirement: Score of 102 or higher

• Check in at the Testing Center (Building 17 Room 250) with your photo ID and receipt.
