In order to participate in the program, you will need to

- 1) Fill out enrollment paperwork and submit to the certifying official along with the contact information for your volunteer site(s). This will include a release allowing us to verify your volunteer service with your chosen site.
- 2) Track your volunteer hours and submit them to your certifying official who will submit them to the PVSA on your behalf.

Once you have joined the program, you will be assigned a username and password which will allow you to access your profile and monitor the entry and accumulation of your volunteer hours. This will help you monitor your progress thru the different levels of the program.
