#### Introduction

The Bachelor of Applied Science in Environmental Sciences program at Clover Park Technical College has admission requirements beyond those necessary for general admission to the college. The admission criteria include your academic record, personal characteristics, and potential to work in the Environmental Sciences field.

Applicants are admitted for a fall, winter, spring and summer quarter start. Please follow all directions in this application carefully. Failure to comply with the process described in this document may result in disqualification from the admissions pool for this program.

### Is This Program Right for You?

CPTC's Bachelor of Applied Science in Environmental Sciences (BAS-ENV) degree has been designed for those pursuing employment as an environmental technician, biological technician, or natural resources technician. The program is also intended to provide advancement opportunities for those currently employed in an environmental field who lack the required credential for that advancement. Graduates with technical associate degree wanting to advance their career options in environmental sciences are welcome to apply.

In the BAS-ENV program, students will learn about laws and regulations involving the environmental and natural resources, develop leadership and management skills, and use scientific methods, data, and instruments in managing and solving real world environmental problems. Focused-study courses and individual capstones help develop the critical thinking skills required for a successful career in an environmental sciences field.

This degree has been designed to meet the educational needs of working adults. It is based on a combination of online, hybrid, and in-person instruction with courses meetings scheduled at times convenient to students.

#### **Admission Requirements**

#### **Academic Requirements for Admission to the Program**

Admission to the program may occur when the following can be documented:

- Successful completion of an earned Applied Associate degree, AAS-T, Direct Transfer
  Associate degree or equivalent from an accredited institution with an overall minimum 2.3
  GPA in all college-level coursework or 90 college-level credits from a regionally accredited
  institution.
- An appropriate body of preparation as determined by the college, including completion of 90 college-level credits, employment, or other life experience that qualifies for credit for <u>prior</u> <u>learning</u> and meets the upper-division course prerequisites.
- A minimum grade of 2.0 is required in all general education coursework
- Completion of ENGL& 101 English Composition or higher equivalent-5 cr
- Completion of a Social Science: PSYC& 100, SOC& 101, or other-5 cr
- GEOL& 110 Environmental Geology w/ Lab, or other earth science with lab
- ENV 164 General Chemistry w/ lab, CHEM& 110, or equivalent chemistry course w/ lab
- ENV 165 Environmental Chemistry w/ lab, or CHEM& 121 or other equivalent chemistry course w/ lab

#### Academic Requirements Prior to the BAS-ENV Senior Year

Once admitted to the program, the following must be documented before you can complete the BAS-ENV program:

- 5 credits of MATH& 146 or another higher-level statistics class.
- ENV 231 Issues in the Urban Environment, or equivalent or instructor permission
- ENV 135 Hazardous Waste Site Operations, or equivalent course
- ENV 251 Environmental Critical Areas or equivalent course
- ENV 260 Introduction to Soils or equivalent course

#### **Graduation Requirements**

To successfully complete the degree, students must maintain a minimum grade of 2.0 in all coursework, including program courses, and general education courses.

#### **Other Admission Requirements**

In addition to meeting the requirements listed on the previous page, you must also submit:

1. Official copies of your transcripts for all of the colleges you have attended other than Clover park Technical College.
