



SHARED GOVERNANCE OPERATIONAL STRUCTURE

COUNCILS are decision-making bodies. They assign work to committees and task forces and receive recommendations back from committees for action or decision. Councils may also solicit feedback from senates as part of their decision-making process to ensure broader input from faculty, staff, and student governance.

COMMITTEES and **TASK FORCES** are advisory bodies that do not typically make final decisions. A committee is a group that meets regularly throughout the year to complete work assigned by the Council. Committees can assign work to a Task Force which are short term commitments, often addressing a specific need or question, then are disbanded when the work is complete. Committees and Task Force are critical in supporting councils by conducting the work, research, analysis, and dialogue needed to inform council deliberation and decision making.
