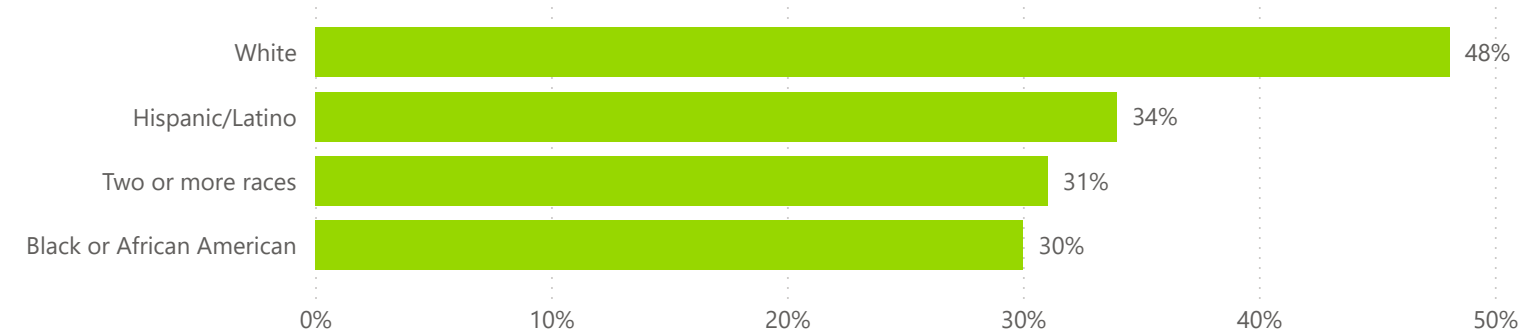

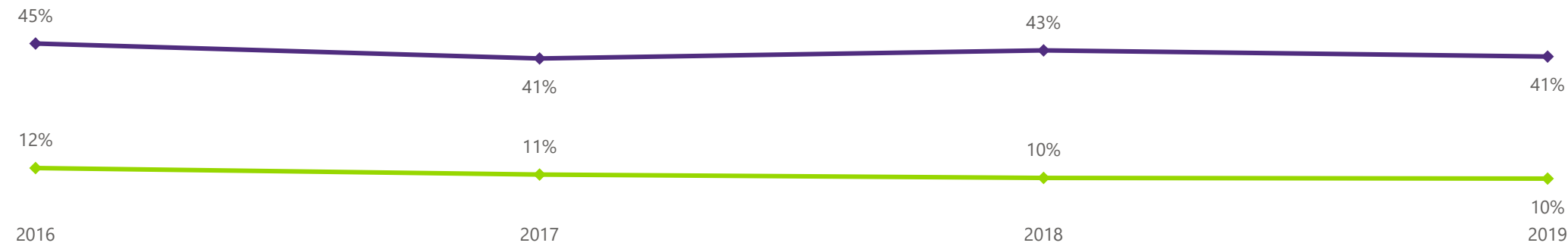

Graduation and Transfer-out Rate Trend (2016–2019 cohorts)

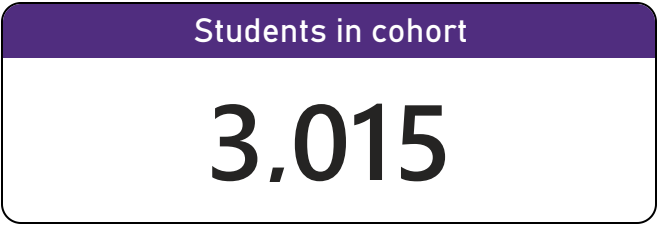
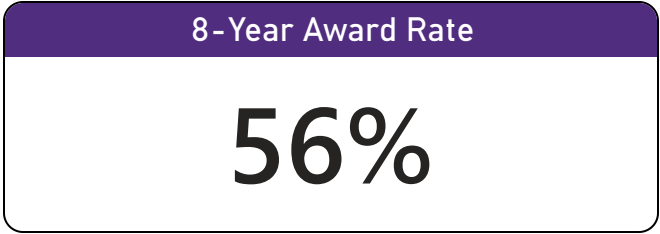
◆ Graduation Rate ◆ Transfer-out Rate



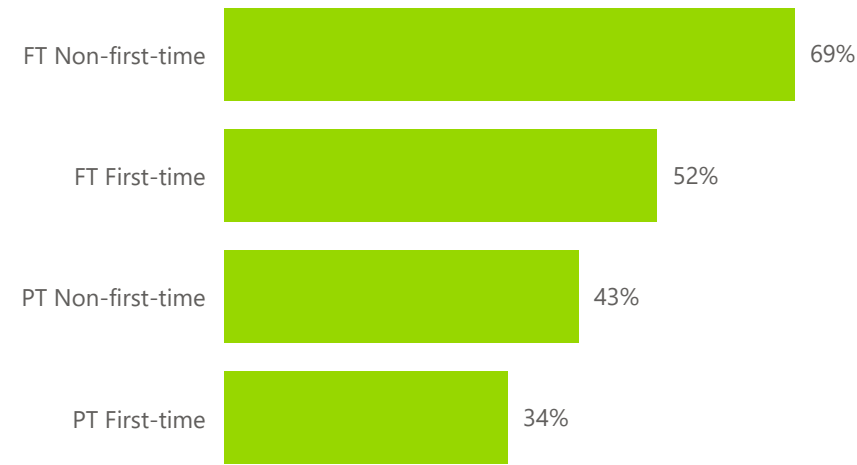
About this data: The federal graduation rate reflects full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students entering Fall 2019 who completed their program within 150% of normal time (by August 31, 2025). The transfer-out rate reflects students from the same cohort known to have transferred to another institution without completing. The 4-year average combines the 2016–2019 entering cohorts, as required under the Student Right-to-Know Act. Rates for all race/ethnicity groups are shown for transparency; groups with fewer than 25 students (†) are based on very small cohorts and can vary widely from year to year. These rates describe 277 entering students; they do not include part-time or returning students, who make up most of Clover Park's enrollment — see the Student Outcomes page for measures covering all students. 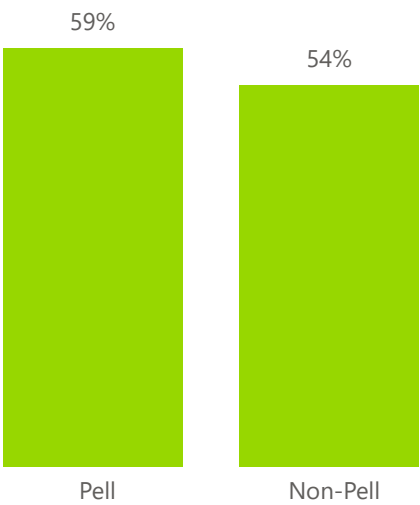


8-Year Award Rate by Enrollment Type

Pell Grant recipients complete at a higher rate than non-Pell students over eight years

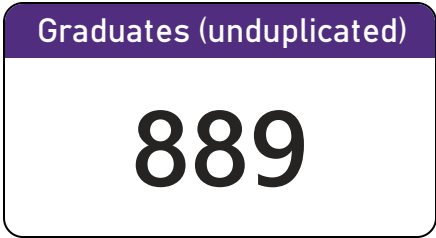
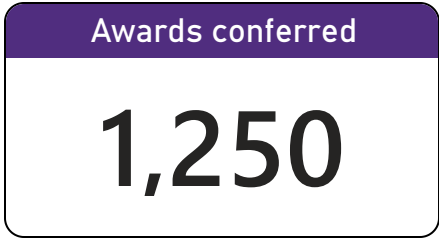
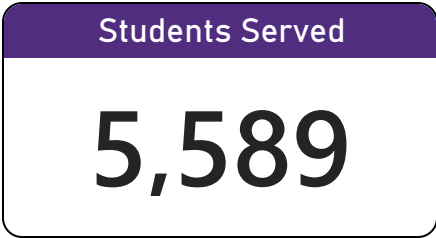

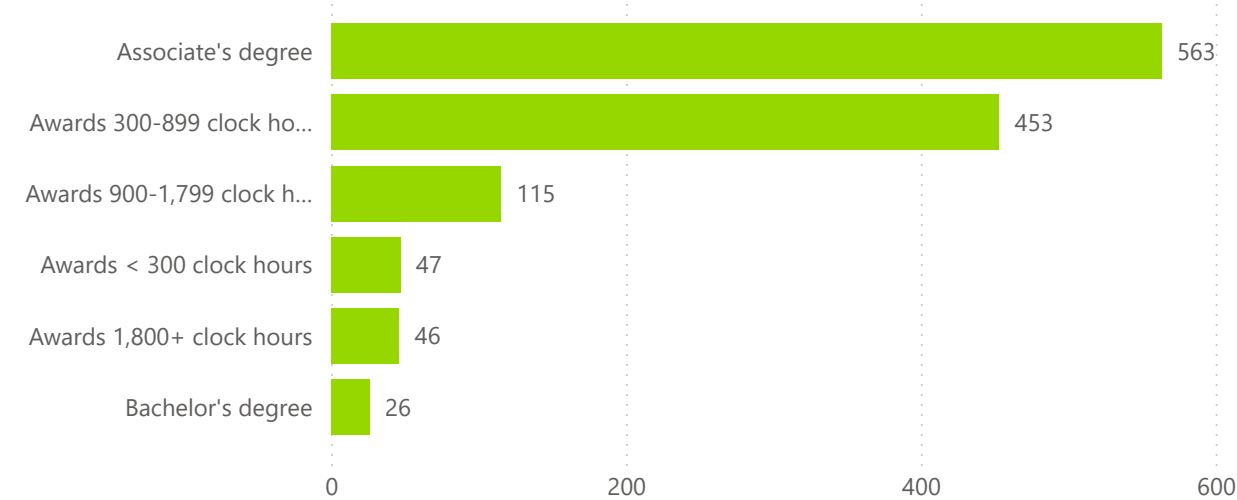
About this data: The 8-year award rate includes *all* degree/certificate-seeking students who entered Clover Park between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018 — full-time and part-time, first-time and returning — and reflects the highest credential earned (certificate, associate, or bachelor's) within eight years, through August 31, 2025. Of 3,015 entering students, 1,697 earned a credential. Unlike the federal graduation rate, this measure covers the part-time and returning students who make up most of Clover Park's enrollment. 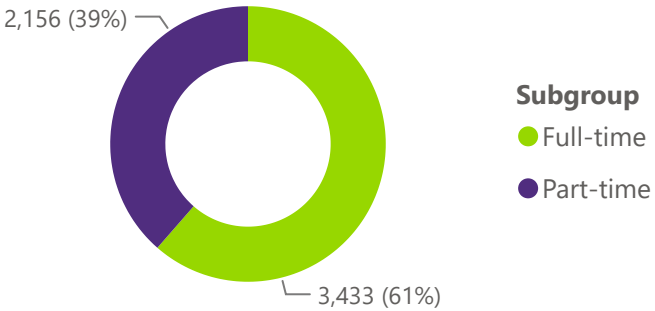
Academic year 2024-25



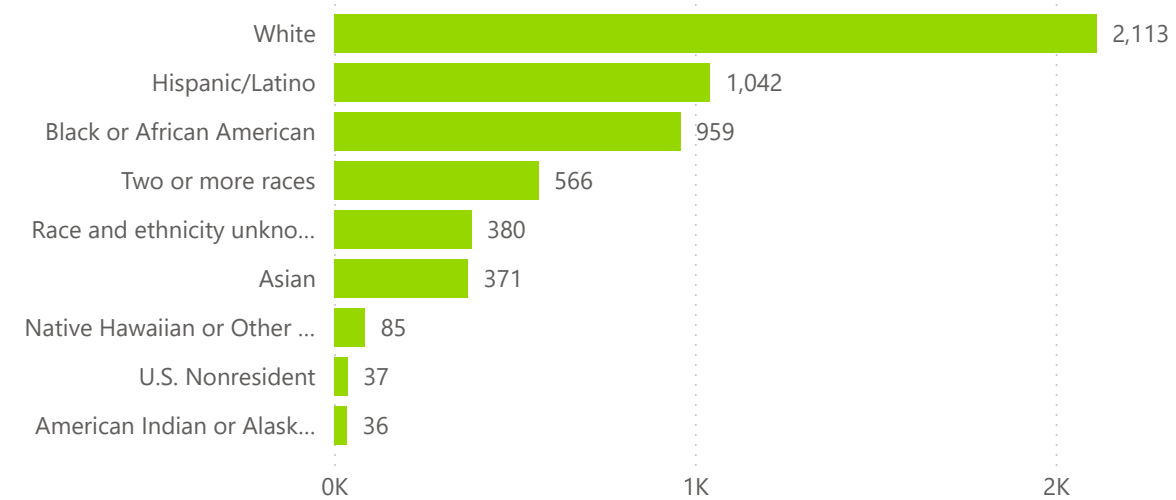
Awards Conferred by Level



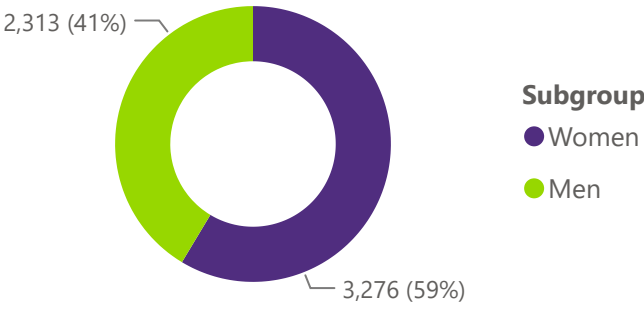
Headcount by attendance

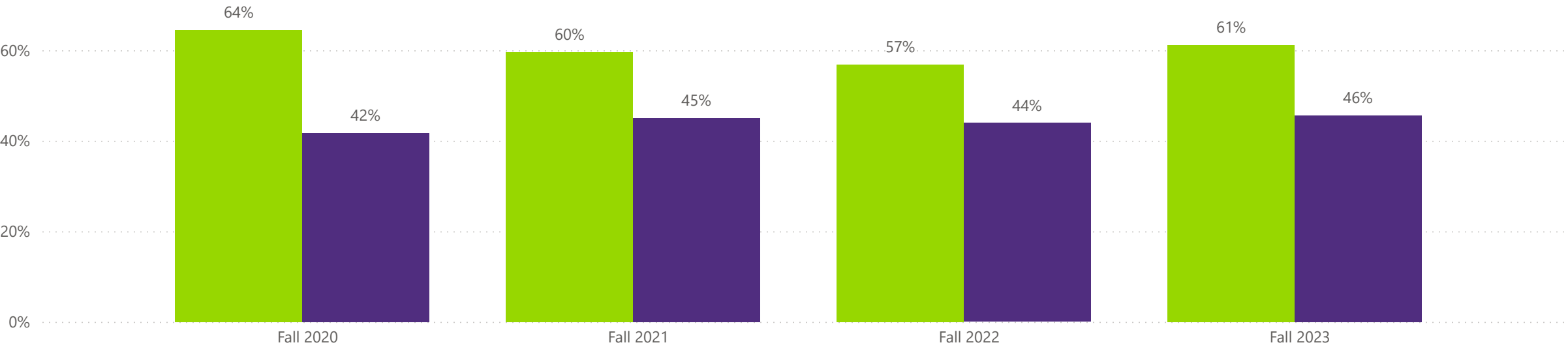

About this data: Clover Park Technical College calculates retention for first-time-in-college students: award-seeking students entering in fall — or entering in summer and continuing into fall — with no prior college enrollment, identified using the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) Education Background derivation and verified against National Student Clearinghouse records. Dual-enrollment (Running Start and similar), international, applied-baccalaureate, and apprenticeship entrants are excluded. Full-time status reflects the entering fall quarter (12+ credits). Retention is the share of each cohort enrolled — or graduated — the following fall. The federal IPEDS retention rate is not applicable to Clover Park: because the college awards bachelor's degrees, IPEDS classifies it as a four-year institution and defines the retention cohort as first-time bachelor's-seeking students; CPTC's bachelor's programs require a prior associate degree, so no students meet that definition. Rates calculated by the Office of Institutional Effectiveness. Most recent cohort: Fall 2023, measured Fall 2024.
