

CPTC Course Equivalency Guide for High Schools



Students getting their high school diploma from their home high school need to know exactly what is needed to meet their graduation requirements for their district. This **planning sheet can be used as a reference tool** if your high school doesn't have their own. You should plan to share your high school course checklist with the Running Start Counselor to help create a Program Map that includes your remaining high school requirements.
