STEP 1	: ELIGIBILITY						
	military or naval service, is determined by federal government to be a prisoner of war or missing in action, or has lost his or her life as a result of active federal military or naval service. Student is a Washington domiciliary (resident) as defined by RCW 28B.15.013. Student meets the school's Academic Progress policy (see College catalog for more information). Student has not exceeded my 250 quarter credit limit using the waiver. Student age is 17-25. (for child only) It has not been 10 years since the veteran's date of death, total disability, or POW/MIA. (for spouse only) Student has not re-married. (for spouse only)
