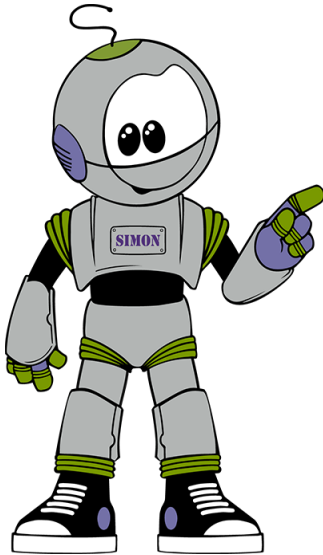


Campus Safety 101
